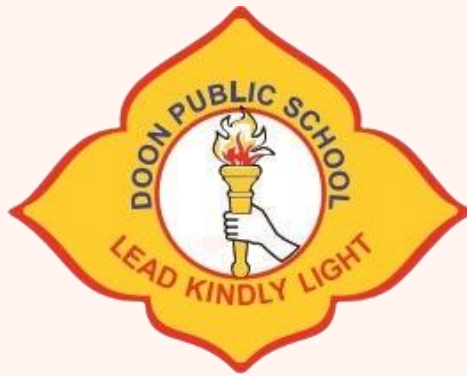

Team Doon looks forward to hearing about your experiences when we return to school.

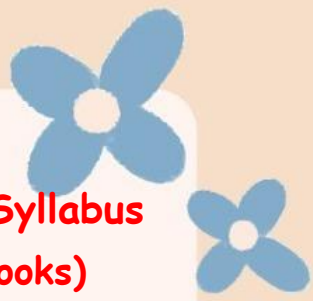
