Background:
Kangra region, with its fertile lands and rich biodiversity, has long been a hub of agricultural activity. However, rapid urbanisation, intensive farming practices, and deforestation have led to alarming rates of soil erosion and

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degradation. As a result, farmers are grappling with dwindling crop yields, loss of fertile topsoil, and environmental degradation.

## - Soil Conservation Initiatives:

## - Terracing and Contour Farming:

$\checkmark$ Recognising the need to curb soil erosion on hilly terrain, local authorities implemented terracing and contour farming techniques.
$\checkmark$ Farmers constructed terraces along the slopes and adopted contour plowing methods to minimise water runoff and soil erosion.

## - Afforestation and Agroforestry:

$\checkmark$ To combat deforestation and enhance soil fertility, extensive afforestation and agroforestry programs were initiated.
$\checkmark$ Farmers were incentivised to plant trees and shrubs on degraded lands, fostering biodiversity, improving soil structure, and providing alternative sources of income.

$\checkmark$ By alternating crops and planting cover crops like legumes, farmers improved soil health, suppressed weed growth, and reduced erosion during fallow periods.


## - Conservation Tillage Techniques:

$\checkmark$ Conventional plowing methods gave way to conservation tillage practices such as no-till and minimum tillage.
$\checkmark$ These techniques minimised soil disturbance, retained crop residues, and improved soil moisture retention, thus mitigating erosion.

- Community Engagement and Education:
$\checkmark$ Local community groups, along with agricultural extension services, played a pivotal role in promoting soil conservation awareness.
$\checkmark$ Workshops, training sessions, and field demonstrations were conducted to educate farmers about the importance of soil
conservation and provide hands-on training in implementing conservation practices.
