उम्र का बेहतरीन हिस्सा है।

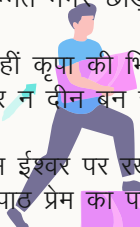

तब तक आगे बढ़े चलो।

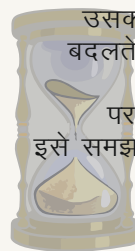

When everyone has something to chase

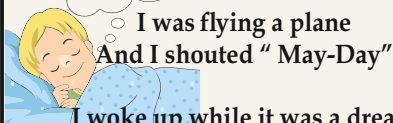

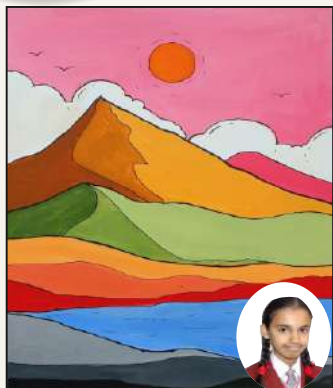

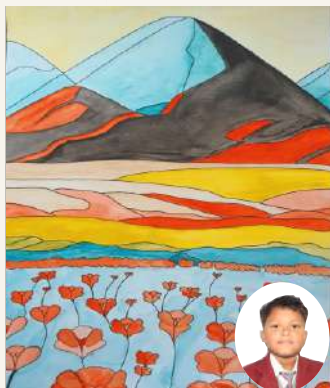
