- Storytelling Sessions: Arrange storytelling sessions where teachers will read stories from different cultures around the world. The stories can include folk tales, myths, and legends, helping students connect with traditions in a fun, relatable way.

- Please find below some **cognitive skills** based activities specially curated for your ward to be taken up at home.
- Memory Matching Game (Object Recall): Class I
- Materials required: Tray, 10-12 small objects (pencil, eraser, toy, key, etc.), cloth to cover objects.
- Instructions: Show your child a tray with the objects for 1 minute. Cover the tray with a cloth. Ask him/her to write or say as many objects as can be remembered. You can increase the difficulty by adding more objects or reducing the viewing time.

### • Class II

- Materials required: Various objects or pictures (different shapes, colors, or categories like animals, vehicles, fruits).
- Instructions: Give your child a set of objects or pictures. Ask him/her to sort these items into categories (e.g., color, size, type). Once he/she would have sorted the items, ask why he/she has placed certain items together. This could foster memory, attention, and reasoning skills. Share the evidences and impression of the activity conducted at home, through fine pictures.

- The best performances from each class during the selection round will participate in the finals on 25.10.24 where the winners will be felicitated.
- The theme for the competition is Folk Dances of India such as Punjabi, Haryanvi, Himachali, Rajasthani, Kashmiri, Gujarati, and Maharashtrian folk dances.
- Students are encouraged to wear costumes/ relevant **attire** and **use props** related to their chosen song.
