- **Skill of the Month-** Logical and Problem-Solving Skills
- As part of our December focus on nurturing logical & problem-solving skills, we have planned a series of engaging activities for our young learners in Grades I & II. These activities are designed to spark curiosity, encourage predictive thinking, build cognitive skills in a fun & interactive manner.



- Skill Day: 06.12.24, 10.12.24, 13.12.24
- On this day, students will indulge in a series of engaging activities arousing curiosity and enhancing their cognition.
- Here is a glimpse of activities curated for our children to be conducted during this month.
- Pattern Recognition: Identifying and completing patterns to develop sequencing skills.
- Simple Puzzles: Solving age-appropriate puzzles to foster critical thinking.
- What's Next?: This activity enhances predictive thinking by presenting scenarios or sequences. For example, "The boy has a balloon; it pops. What happens next?" Your child will predict logical outcomes and share their thoughts.






- Riddles and Brain Teasers: Using simple riddles suited to their age, students will engage their problem-solving skills. An example: "I am round and I roll. You kick me on the ground. What am I?" (Answer: A ball)
- Follow the Leader: In this activity, students will replicate a sequence of movements (e.g., clap, stomp, hop) and creatively add a new movement. This tests their memory, logical thinking, and creativity.
- We are excited to see our tiny tots explore these activities and grow in confidence and skill. We seek your support in reinforcing these skills at home through activities like puzzles, story discussions, or simple Maths games.
