SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	 Recap of Small cursive letters. Introduction of Capital cursive letters. Introduction of vowel a, and related exercises Jolly phonics revision. 	Students will be able to: Remember: The sound of vowels and associated vocabulary words. Understand: the role of vowel 'a' in forming simple CVC (Consonant-Vowel-Consonant) words Apply: correct strokes to write capital cursive letters neatly. Analyze: Words based on their beginning sounds and vowel sounds.
MATHS	 Forward counting (1-120) Recap of backward counting (30-1). Concept of Big and Small, Tall and Short Shapes Circle and Triangle 	Students will be able to: Remember:Forward counting from 1 to 120 and backward counting from 30 to 1. Understand: The concepts of size (big/small) and height (tall/short). Apply: Knowledge to sequence numbers correctly and identify shapes like circle and triangle in everyday objects. Analyze: compare objects based on their size, height, and shape.
HINDI	 स्वर, व्यंजन का अभ्यास विषय से संबंवित अभ्यास 	Students will be able to: Remember: All বিব and আঁজন letters accurately and recognize them by their shapes and sounds. Understand: The basic differences between বিব and আঁজন. Apply: The knowledge of বিব and আঁজন to form and read two-letter and three-letter Hindi words. Analyze: A group of letters and correctly sort them into বিব and আঁজন categories.

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	 Recap of vowel sound "a" and related exercises. Introduction of vowel sound "e" and related exercises. Introduction of vowel sound "i" Introduction of vowel sound "o" and related exercises 	Students will be able to: Remember: Identify and pronounce the vowel sounds "e", "i", and "o" correctly. Understand: Recognize the difference in pronunciation and usage of vowel sounds in simple words. Apply: Use the vowel sounds in related exercises like matching, filling in blanks, or picture-word associations. Analyze: Compare vowel sounds (e.g., "i" vs. "e") and sort words based on the vowel sound they contain.
MATHS	 Introduction of Forward counting from (121-200) Introduction of Backward counting from (40-1) Concept Thick-Thin and Heavy - Light. Shapes-Rectangle and Square. Introduction of Number Names (1-5) 	Remember: Identify numbers from 121 to 200 in forward sequence and from 40 to 1 in backward sequence. Understand: Demonstrate awareness of number order, quantity, and directional sequencing through counting activities. Apply: Use number recognition and comparison skills to solve basic exercises, match number names (1–5), and categorize objects based on thickness and weight. Analyze: Differentiate between thick and thin, heavy and light objects; and compare rectangle vs. square by analyzing their properties (sides and corners).
HINDI	 हिंदी स्वर और व्यंजन दो अक्षर वाले सरल हिंदी शब्द 	Students will be able to: Remember: To identify the shapes, sounds, and names of Hindi swar and vyanjan. Understand: The difference between swar and vyanjan and recognize them by their sound. Apply: Combine swar and vyanjan to read and form simple two-letter Hindi words. Analyze: Compare two-letter words based on sound and structure.

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	 Introduction of vowel sound u" and related exercises. Introduction of sight words or tricky words. Introduction of double letters. 	Students will be able to: Remember: The vowel sound <i>u</i> , sight words, and common double letters correctly. Understand: How vowel sounds, sight words, and double letters function in simple words. Apply: Their knowledge by reading and using sight words, and identifying double letters in words. Analyze: Words to differentiate between regular words, sight words, and those with double letters.
MATHS	 Introduction of Number Names (6-15). Introduction of Backward Counting (100-61) Concepts: Right-Left Greater than, smaller than and equal to. Shapes-oval and star. 	Students will be able to: Remember: Number names (6–15), backward counting (100–61), and the shapes oval and star. Understand: The concepts of right–left and greater than, smaller than, and equal to. Apply: Their knowledge by writing number names, performing backward counting, and identifying shapes in their surroundings. Analyze: Numbers using greater than, smaller than, and equal to, and differentiate between right and left.
HINDI	तीन अक्षर वाले शब्द	Students will be able to: Remember: To recognize and read three-letter words (जैसे- कमल, गजल, चमन) Understand: The meaning of these words and connect them with pictures or objects. Apply: To use three-letter words to form simple sentences. Analyze: To identify and compare words based on letters and sounds (जैसे- कमल और कमर, सड़क – कड़क)
