SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	➤ Strokes - Standing & Sleeping lines ➤ Introduction to letter I, L, T	Students will be able to: Remember: Identify standing and sleeping lines; recall the sound and shape of letter I, L and T. Understand: Differentiate between standing and sleeping lines; recognize objects beginning with the letter I, L, T. Apply: Draw standing and sleeping lines to form shapes or letters; trace and write the letter L, T, I. Analyze: Observe patterns in lines used in letters.
MATHS	➤ Introduction to numbers 1, 4 & 7 ➤ Introduction to number 1, 4, 7 ➤ Basic Pre-Math Concepts • Big and small • Shape: Circle • Colour: Red	Students will be able to: Remember: Identify and name numbers 1, 4, and 7. Understand: Relate the numbers to quantities (e.g., 1 apple, 4 pencils, 7 blocks). Apply: Trace and write numbers using crayons, sand tray, or worksheets; count objects during play. Analyze: See which number is bigger or smaller using pictures or toys.

Analyze: The similarities and differences between the letters based on their structure (straight lines vs. curves).
