SYLLABUS FOR APRIL- MAY

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	➤ Recap of Small cursive letters. ➤ Introduction of Capital cursive letters. ➤ Introduction of vowel a, and related exercises ➤ Jolly phonics revision.	Students will be able to: Remember: The sound of vowels and associated vocabulary words. Understand: the role of vowel 'a' in forming simple CVC (Consonant-Vowel-Consonant) words. Apply: correct strokes to write capital cursive letters neatly. Analyze: Words based on their beginning sounds and vowel sounds.
MATHS	➤ Forward counting (1-120) ➤ Recap of backward counting (30-1). ➤ Concept of Big and Small, Tall and Short ➤ Shapes Circle and Triangle	Students will be able to: Remember: Forward counting from 1 to 120 and backward counting from 30 to 1. Understand: The concepts of size (big/small) and height (tall/short). Apply: Knowledge to sequence numbers correctly and identify shapes like circle and triangle in everyday objects. Analyze: Compare objects based on their size, height, and shape.
HINDI	➤ स्वर, व्यंजन का अभ्यास ➤ विषय से संबंधित अभ्यास	Students will be able to: Remember: All स्वर and व्यंजन letters accurately and recognize them by their shapes and sounds. Understand: The basic differences between स्वर and व्यंजन. Apply: The knowledge of स्वर and व्यंजन to form and read two-letter and three-letter Hindi words. Analyze: A group of letters and correctly sort them into स्वर and व्यंजन categories.

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	➤ Recap of vowel sound "a" and related exercises. ➤ Introduction of vowel sound "e" and related exercises. ➤ Introduction of vowel sound "i" ➤ Introduction of vowel sound "o" and related exercises	Students will be able to: Remember: Identify and pronounce the vowel sounds "e", "i", and "o" correctly. Understand: Recognize the difference in pronunciation and usage of vowel sounds in simple words. Apply: Use the vowel sounds in related exercises like matching, filling in blanks, or picture-word associations. Analyze: Compare vowel sounds (e.g., "i" vs. "e") and sort words based on the vowel sound they contain.
MATHS	➤ Introduction of Forward counting from (121- 200) ➤ Introduction of Backward counting from (40-1) ➤ Concept Thick-Thin and Heavy - Light. ➤ Shapes-Rectangle and Square. ➤ Introduction of Number Names (1-5)	Students will be able to: Remember: Identify numbers from 121 to 200 in forward sequence and from 40 to 1 in backward sequence. Understand: Demonstrate awareness of number order, quantity, and directional sequencing through counting activities. Apply: Use number recognition and comparison skills to solve basic exercises, match number names (1–5), and categorize objects based on thickness and weight. Analyze: Differentiate between thick and thin, heavy and light objects; and compare rectangle vs. square by analyzing their properties (sides and corners).
HINDI	➤ हिंदी स्वर और व्यंजन ➤ दो अक्षर वाले सरल हिंदी शब्द	Students will be able to: Remember: To identify the shapes, sounds, and names of Hindi swar and vyanjan. Understand: The difference between swar and vyanjan and recognize them by their sound. Apply: Combine swar and vyanjan to read and form simple two-letter Hindi words. Analyze: Compare two-letter words based on sound and structure.



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SYLLABUS FOR SEPTEMBER- OCTOBER

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	➤ Introduction of vowel sound u" and related exercises. ➤ Introduction of sight words or tricky words. ➤ Introduction of double letters.	Students will be able to: Remember: The vowel sound <i>u</i>, sight words, and common double letters correctly. Understand: How vowel sounds, sight words, and double letters function in simple words. Apply: Their knowledge by reading and using sight words, and identifying double letters in words. Analyze: Words to differentiate between regular words, sight words, and those with double letters.
MATHS	➤ Introduction of Number Names (6-15). ➤ Introduction of Backward Counting (100-61) ➤ Concepts: Right-Left Greater than, smaller than and equal to. Shapes-oval and star.	Students will be able to: Remember: Number names (6–15), backward counting (100–61), and the shapes oval and star. Understand: The concepts of right–left and greater than, smaller than, and equal to. Apply: Their knowledge by writing number names, performing backward counting, and identifying shapes in their surroundings. Analyze: Numbers using greater than, smaller than, and equal to, and differentiate between right and left.
HINDI	➤ तीन अक्षर वाले शब्द	Students will be able to: Remember: To recognize and read three-letter words (जैसे- कमल, गजल, चमन). Understand: The meaning of these words and connect them with pictures or objects. Apply: To use three-letter words to form simple sentences. Analyze: To identify and compare words based on letters and sounds (जैसे- कमल और कमर, सड़क – कड़क)



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SYLLABUS FOR NOVEMBER- DECEMBER

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	➤ Introduction of a/an ➤ Introduction of sound blends ➤ Introduction of parts of body	Students will be able to: Remember: The correct use of <i>a/an</i>, recognize basic sound blends (e.g., <i>bl, cl, st...</i>), and name the main parts of the body. Understand: The difference between a and an based on vowel and consonant sounds, identify sound blends within words, and understand the function of each body part. Apply: Use <i>a/an</i> correctly in sentences, read and spell words with common blends, and identify body parts through speaking and labeling activities. Analyze: Differentiate between correct and incorrect usage of <i>a/an</i>, compare words with similar blends, and analyze how different body parts help in daily activities.
MATHS	➤ Introduction of Number Names (16-20). ➤ Introduction of single digit addition ➤ Introduction of single digit subtraction ➤ Concept - Odd one out ➤ Shapes- half circle	Students will be able to: Remember: Number names from 16 to 20 and recognize symbols and signs for addition (+) and subtraction (–). Understand: The concepts of addition as putting together and subtraction as taking away; identify differences among objects in the Odd One Out activity; and recognize the half-circle shape in daily life. Apply: Use number names correctly while writing or reading numbers, perform simple single-digit addition and subtraction sums, and identify half-circle shapes and odd objects in given sets. Analyze: Compare and differentiate between addition and subtraction operations, observe patterns in number sequences (16–20), and reason why one object is the “odd one out” in a group.
HINDI	➤ चार अक्षर वाले शब्द ➤ वाक्य रचना - चार अक्षर वाले शब्द	Students will be able to: Remember: To recognize and read चार अक्षर वाले शब्द correctly from the given list or textbook. Understand: The meaning of four-letter words and relate them to pictures or real-life objects. Apply: To use चार अक्षर वाले शब्द to form simple and meaningful sentences orally and in writing. Analyze: Differentiate between तीन अक्षर वाले and चार अक्षर वाले शब्द by identifying the number of letters and sounds in each word.
