ENGLISH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Recap of Small cursive letters.</li> <li>➤ Introduction of Capital cursive letters.</li> <li>➤ Introduction of vowel a, and related exercises</li> <li>➤ Jolly phonics revision.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> The sound of vowels and associated vocabulary words.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> the role of vowel 'a' in forming simple CVC (Consonant-Vowel-Consonant) words.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> correct strokes to write capital cursive letters neatly.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Words based on their beginning sounds and vowel sounds.</p>
MATHS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Forward counting (1-120)</li> <li>➤ Recap of backward counting (30-1).</li> <li>➤ Concept of Big and Small, Tall and Short</li> <li>➤ Shapes Circle and Triangle</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> Forward counting from 1 to 120 and backward counting from 30 to 1.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> The concepts of size (big/small) and height (tall/short).</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Knowledge to sequence numbers correctly and identify shapes like circle and triangle in everyday objects.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Compare objects based on their size, height, and shape.</p>

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
ENGLISH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Recap of vowel sound "a" and related exercises.</li> <li>➤ Introduction of vowel sound "e" and related exercises.</li> <li>➤ Introduction of vowel sound "i"</li> <li>➤ Introduction of vowel sound "o" and related exercises</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> Identify and pronounce the vowel sounds "e", "i", and "o" correctly.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> Recognize the difference in pronunciation and usage of vowel sounds in simple words.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Use the vowel sounds in related exercises like matching, filling in blanks, or picture-word associations.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Compare vowel sounds (e.g., "i" vs. "e") and sort words based on the vowel sound they contain.</p>
MATHS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Introduction of Forward counting from (121- 200)</li> <li>➤ Introduction of Backward counting from (40-1)</li> <li>➤ Concept Thick-Thin and Heavy - Light.</li> <li>➤ Shapes-Rectangle and Square.</li> <li>➤ Introduction of Number Names (1-5)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> Identify numbers from 121 to 200 in forward sequence and from 40 to 1 in backward sequence.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> Demonstrate awareness of number order, quantity, and directional sequencing through counting activities.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Use number recognition and comparison skills to solve basic exercises, match number names (1-5), and categorize objects based on thickness and weight.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Differentiate between thick and thin, heavy and light objects; and compare rectangle vs. square by analyzing their properties (sides and corners).</p>

ENGLISH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Introduction of vowel sound u" and related exercises.</li> <li>➤ Introduction of sight words or tricky words.</li> <li>➤ Introduction of double letters.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> The vowel sound <i>u</i>, sight words, and common double letters correctly.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> How vowel sounds, sight words, and double letters function in simple words.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Their knowledge by reading and using sight words, and identifying double letters in words.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Words to differentiate between regular words, sight words, and those with double letters.</p>
MATHS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Introduction of Number Names (6-15).</li> <li>➤ Introduction of Backward Counting (100-61)</li> <li>➤ Concepts: Right-Left Greater than, smaller than and equal to. Shapes-oval and star.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> Number names (6-15), backward counting (100-61), and the shapes oval and star.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> The concepts of right-left and greater than, smaller than, and equal to.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Their knowledge by writing number names, performing backward counting, and identifying shapes in their surroundings.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Numbers using greater than, smaller than, and equal to, and differentiate between right and left.</p>
HINDI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ तीन अक्षर वाले शब्द</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> To recognize and read three-letter words (जैसे- कमल, गजल, चमन).</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> The meaning of these words and connect them with pictures or objects.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> To use three-letter words to form simple sentences.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> To identify and compare words based on letters and sounds (जैसे- कमल और कमर, सड़क – कड़क)</p>

SUBJECT	TOPIC	LEARNING OUTCOMES
<b>ENGLISH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Introduction of a/an</li> <li>➤ Introduction of sound blends</li> <li>➤ Introduction of parts of body</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> The correct use of <i>a/an</i>, recognize basic sound blends (e.g., <i>bl</i>, <i>cl</i>, <i>st</i>...), and name the main parts of the body.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> The difference between <i>a</i> and <i>an</i> based on vowel and consonant sounds, identify sound blends within words, and understand the function of each body part.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Use <i>a/an</i> correctly in sentences, read and spell words with common blends, and identify body parts through speaking and labeling activities.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Differentiate between correct and incorrect usage of <i>a/an</i>, compare words with similar blends, and analyze how different body parts help in daily activities.</p>
<b>MATHS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Introduction of Number Names (16-20).</li> <li>➤ Introduction of single digit addition</li> <li>➤ Introduction of single digit subtraction</li> <li>➤ Concept - Odd one out</li> <li>➤ Shapes- half circle</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> Number names from 16 to 20 and recognize symbols and signs for addition (+) and subtraction (-).</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> The concepts of addition as putting together and subtraction as taking away; identify differences among objects in the Odd One Out activity; and recognize the half-circle shape in daily life.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Use number names correctly while writing or reading numbers, perform simple single-digit addition and subtraction sums, and identify half-circle shapes and odd objects in given sets.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Compare and differentiate between addition and subtraction operations, observe patterns in number sequences (16–20), and reason why one object is the “odd one out” in a group.</p>
<b>HINDI</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ चार अक्षर वाले शब्द</li> <li>➤ वाक्य रचना - चार अक्षर वाले शब्द</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> To recognize and read चार अक्षर वाले शब्द correctly from the given list or textbook.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> The meaning of four-letter words and relate them to pictures or real-life objects.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> To use चार अक्षर वाले शब्द to form simple and meaningful sentences orally and in writing.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Differentiate between तीन अक्षर वाले and चार अक्षर वाले शब्द by identifying the number of letters and sounds in each word.</p>

MATHS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Patterns</li> <li>➤ Recapitulation of subtraction, addition and all the mathematical concepts</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students will be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Remember:</b> Recognize number patterns and recall basic addition and subtraction facts.</p> <p><b>Understand:</b> Show understanding of patterns and number operations through oral responses and activities.</p> <p><b>Apply:</b> Create and extend simple patterns using objects, colours, and numbers.</p> <p><b>Analyze:</b> Identify missing elements in patterns.</p>
