## Pariksha Pe Charcha: Inspiring Confidence and Positive Thinking

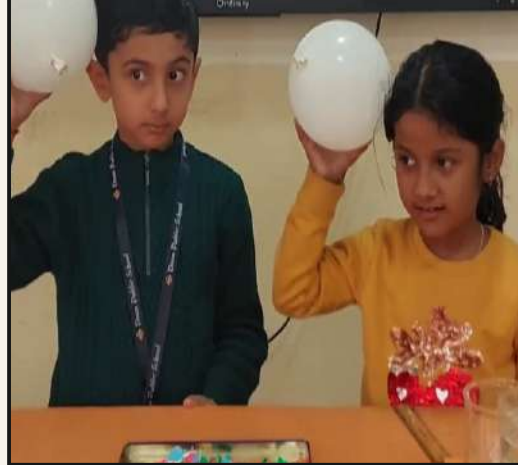
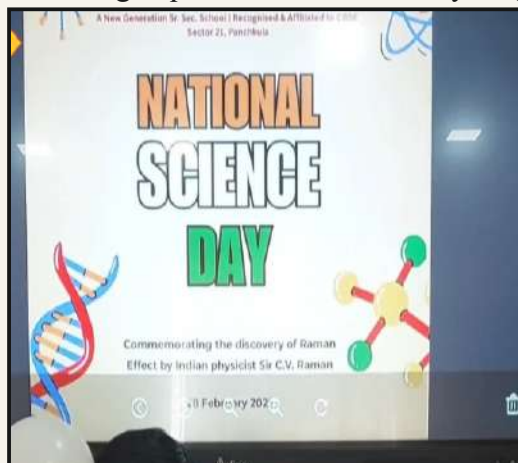

On this day, the president of India hoist the national flag and a ground parade is held in New Delhi. The parade shows India's culture, strength and unity.



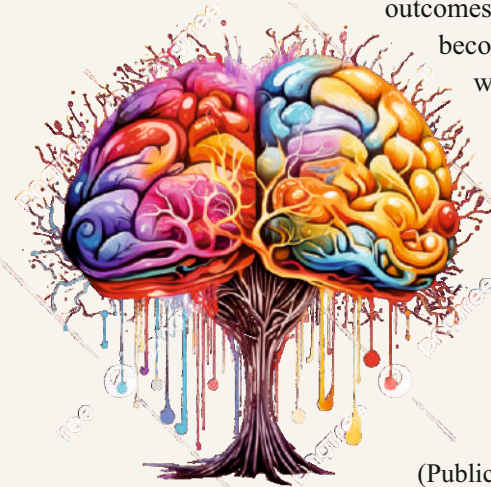
