April to May	Chapter No. – 1 A Day At The Beach (Counting In Groups)	Students will be able to: Remember: recall numbers up to 100 Identify tens and ones Understand: the place value (tens and ones) Apply: form numbers using tens and ones Solve simple problems using grouping (e.g., making groups of 10 Analyze: compare numbers (greater/smaller) Break numbers into tens and ones.

	Chapter No. – 2 Shapes Around Us (3 D Shapes)	Remember: recall and name common 3D shapes like cube, cuboid, cone, cylinder, and sphere Understand: the difference between shapes (e.g., cube vs cuboid). Apply: relate 3D shapes to real-life objects (e.g., ball → sphere, bottle → cylinder). Learners will sort and group objects based on shapes Analyze: compare shapes based on properties (rolling, sliding, stacking).
	Chapter No. – 3 Fun This Numbers (Numbers 1 to 100)	Students will be able to: Remember: recognize number names and numerals. Identify forward and backward counting Understand: skip counting (by 2s, 3s, 5s, 10s), before, after, and between numbers. Apply: Use number line to show counting and jumps..Fill missing numbers in sequences and patterns. Analyze: Differentiate between number patterns e.g., +2, +5 sequences and Compare numbers (greater than, less than, equal to).

July to August	Chapter No. – 4 Shadow story (Togalu)	Students will be able to: Remember: basic 2D and 3D shapes such as circle, square, triangle, cube, cuboid, cone, and cylinder. Understand: how shadows change according to shape and position. Describe how patterns repeat using shapes and shadows. Apply: Create shadow stories using cut-outs of shapes. Arrange shapes to form new objects or characters. Analyze: Identify repeating and non-repeating patterns. Examine how changing the position of light affects shadows.
	Chapter No. – 5 Playing with lines	Students will be able to: Remember: different types of lines such as straight, curved, zigzag, slanting, horizontal, and vertical lines. Understand: how lines are used to create shapes, patterns, and drawings. Apply: Create simple pictures and patterns using lines Analyze: line patterns in artworks and objects.
	Chapter No. – 6 Decoration for festival	Students will be able to: Remember: symbols used in addition (+), subtraction (–), and equal to (=). Understand: how number lines help in adding and subtracting. Apply: Use blocks, beads, or objects to perform addition and subtraction. Analyze: Break numbers into smaller parts to solve problems.

Apply: Practice personal hygiene, follow good manners in school, follow a daily routine independently. Analyze: good habits and bad habits, right or wrong behaviour, recognise effects of bad habits

Understand: Basic functions of different plant parts, Differentiate between various kinds of plants, Apply: Classify plants found in the surroundings, Practice caring for plants by watering and protecting them. Analyze: Compare different types of plants based on size and stem, Observe similarities and differences among leaves, flowers, and stems.
	Chapter No. – 5 Name of the Chapter- The World of Animals	Students will be able to: Remember: The name of different animals around them, Recall names of animals, Name body parts and homes of animals. Understand: the differences between domestic and wild animals, Describe the food habits and habitats of animals Apply: Classify animals into groups such as wild, domestic etc, Match animals with their homes and food habits. Analyze: Compare animals based on size, food habits, and habitat. Differentiate between herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores.
